

INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING PATIENT INITIAL EVALUATION FORM

- 1.** First page of the form is completed by the health care practitioner
- 2.** Second page of the form, the BPI or Brief Pain Inventory is to be completed by the patient. Brief Pain Inventory should be completed at initial start of therapy then again at the end of treatment. Patient will circle or write in answer except for question 2. Patient will color in pain area for question 2.
- 3.** Brief Pain Inventory is not to be altered. Brief Pain Inventory is copyrighted. CTTC has permission from the author to use this tool in a clinical practice setting. Sites deciding to use this tool for research purposes must apply to University of Texas MD Anderson Cancer Center.
